How do I get connected?

1. Coming along to a church service is a great way to start. We have a time of worship, a sermon and prayer. The children stay in for the first part of the service and then go to their own groups. Morning tea happens after each morning service. Being around at this time helps you meet others and gives you a chance to look at the notice boards for other ways to get involved as and when you want to.
